Đại học Đà Nẵng đề nghị Trường Đại học Kinh tế tổ chức buổi làm việc này, nội dung cụ thể như sau:

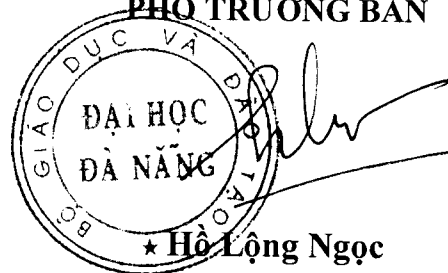

Memorandum of Understanding
between
The University of Danang, Vietnam
and
King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, Thailand

The University of Danang and King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang hereby agree to promote mutual cooperation in order to strengthen the relationship between the people of the two countries and to further the advancement of education, research and training.

Both universities agree with the following contents according to the fund that can be offered by both sides:

1. Exchange academic visit of university staff and students;
2. Joint research activities of faculty and research scholars;
3. Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students;
4. Exchange of materials in education and research, publication and academic information;
5. International extension and outreach activities.

Collaboration shall not be only limited to the above mentioned items, but also extended to other aspects according to mutual interest. The details shall be discussed by both sides once the General Agreement is signed.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) shall become effective once signed by both universities and remain valid for 5 years. At the end of this period, the MOU shall be subject to renewal or modifications by mutual consent of both parties.

As witness to their agreement to the above articles, the representatives of King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang and The University of Danang have hereunto provided their endorsement.
